Badadon Sangho is a women's rights and women-led organisation, working for single mother, separated, widow, divorce, religious minority's women and girls. It is (a non-profit and non political organisation) working since January 2015 by a group of motivated and dedicated development women activists.

Our Vision

To establish a society based on freedom of expression, in which all people particularly women and girls have full and effective participation in the economic and social development process.

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Develop women's organisation and voices:

We the group put heads together to facilitate local level protest events to protect property rights, access to water-bodies and drinking water and violence against women. In addition, continuous meetings, coaching and mentoring supports provide to committee members to enhance capacity in articulation, speaking and expression. A total of 3,320 women and girls were engaged in 66 women organisations.

- Policy advocacy

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Women's control over lands and water-bodies

Women aware on land and water-bodies' ownership documents i.e. how to claim property including understanding on parcel maps, deed, records, registration, succession certificate, tax receipts and mutation records. Essentially, the team works to promote objective and subjective security of women's tenure rights.

Activities

- Spatial data collection and mapping
- Land literacy training
- Meeting with land offices
- Database of women's successors
- Legal aid support to claim ownership



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Violence against women and girls

In order to expel women from property rights, silent and open violence against women and girls increasing day by days. Programme expanded its support to 900 women and girls for next three years and engaging men and boys to change their own behaviour.

Activities

- Engagement with men and youths
- Involvement with legal aid committee, local elected bodies
- Use of folk songs, posters and flipchart
- Legal aid assistance

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Women in climate change:

In the Bay of Bengal belt and Sundarbans mangrove forest areas, women are adversely affected by climate and environmental changes i.e. intrusion of salinity, cyclone, sea level raise, and onwards land investment. Technical skill transfer for income generation is one of the key tools, similarly creation of evidences and stories for policy discourse as well essential, we work for.

Activities

- Skill transfer training
- Meeting with stakeholders
- Documentation



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Case Study of Fazultinessa Begum

"The demand of lands has increased in my areas because of industrialisation. Brokers are scoping disputes on small piece of inherited lands. I know that mutation of land record is essential to establish my rights. In order to get the mutation, lots of documents, money and assistance of broker were required. I heard some women applying and running to offices and brokers. So I was reluctant to apply for mutation. Badabon Sangho has facilitated visits to land office, we talked over how to get mutation. Finally I received the mutated land record document. My story made other women in our village hopeful to collect ownership documents -

Fazultinessa Begum who received mutation in Burirdanga village".
